Variance

If you receive a Variance Order from the VWC indicating a possible underpayment on a JCN, it is very important that you review the total amount awarded to the claimant and the total amount reported as paid on the last accepted SROI transaction.

If, after your review, you determine:

- There is truly an underpayment, the owed amount should be immediately sent to the claimant and an updated EDI transaction filed showing the updated payment amount.
- The total amount paid reported on your last SROI transaction was incorrect and you have actually paid more, you should immediately file a new SROI transaction reflecting the correct amount paid.
- The awarded compensation is incorrect, you should contact the VWC's Claims Services Department either in writing or by calling the Commission toll free number (877-664-2566).
