Reminder – Variance Orders

The Variance Notification is issued when the amount paid, as reported by the Claim Administrator via EDI, varies from what the Commission awarded and there is an underpayment of more than \$50. Claim Administrators should ensure that the total amount paid is reported on each transaction submitted. No additional EDI transactions are necessary if the information reported as paid is correct. If the awarded information appears to be incorrect, please contact the Commission's Claims Services Department.

Reminder – BTC 240

Benefit Type Code 240 (Employer Paid Unspecified) should only be used to report payments when the specific benefit type paid by the employer is unknown. If your company was noted as the Claim Administrator of record at the time each indemnity benefit was awarded, the appropriate benefit type code should be used to report the specific benefit paid. For example: The Commission awarded the claimant Temporary Total Benefits and the claimant received salary in lieu of comp, code 250 should be used not 240.

Annual Trading Partner Review

It is time for the EDI QA Department to begin its annual review of all Trading Partner information. We know for some it may seem like we just did this but in fact, it was started one year ago! Starting in May, we will begin reaching out to all Claim Administrators to have them review the information we currently have on file for their company. If the information is still correct, a simple reply advising us of such is all that is needed. If changes are needed, Elizabeth Patrick will work with you to be sure we get all updated documentation submitted and changes made to our systems.
