## **Annual Trading Partner Review**

It is time for the EDI QA Department to begin its annual review of all Trading Partner information. Starting in May, we will begin reaching out to all Claim Administrators to have them review the information we currently have on file for their company. If the information is still correct, a simple reply advising us of such is all that is needed. If changes are needed, simply update those changes on your electronic Trading Partner Profile and we will get the changes made to our systems.

## **Reporting Compromise Settlement Payments**

Many Claim Administrators and their Attorneys have reached out to the Commission recently with questions about how to report the payment of a Compromise Settlement once it has been approved by the Commission. We would like to remind you all that there are different ways to report the payments when more than one JCN is settled at a time and it all depends on how the settlement is written.

In order to assist our customers with reporting Compromise Settlement payments, there is a training aid available on our website that will outline exactly how EDI should be filed. The training aid is titled EDI Training Aid #11 - Reporting of Compromise Settlements. We strongly recommend taking a look at this document as a refresher

### **Update: EDI Release 3.1 in Virginia**

As previously announced, the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission will be migrating to the IAIABC EDI Release 3.1 in January 2025. In early 2022, the Commission's EDI Quality Assurance Department began their review the IAIABC's EDI Release 3.1 standard and began development of the R3.1 Tables for Virginia. We are happy to report that we have completed this process and passed the tables on to the IAIABC's EDI Implementation Team for review and feedback. Once we receive their feedback, we will make any necessary changes and then the tables will be published for the Claim Administrator community to begin their review and development in preparation of our go-live in 2025.
