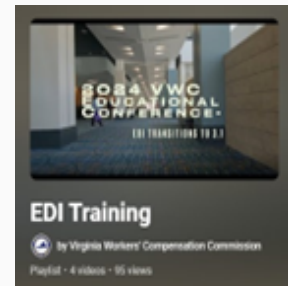

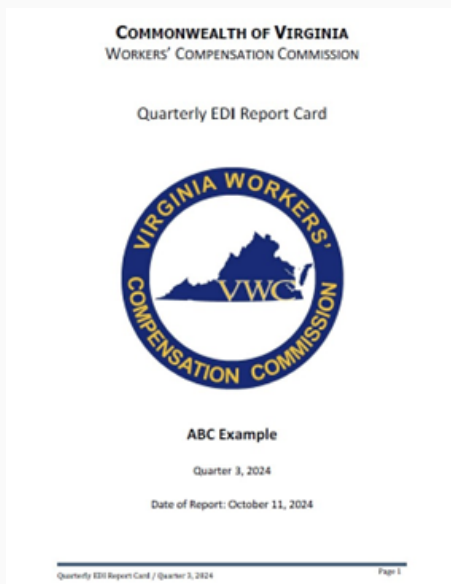

## EDI Release 3.1

As you all are aware, the Commission is transitioning to the IAIABC's EDI Release 3.1 Standard effective January 16, 2025. In preparation for this release, here are a few reminders:

- Our Implementation Guide and Requirement Tables can be located on the the EDI Quality Assurance Page of the Commission's website: <https://www.workcomp.virginia.gov/content/edi-quality-assurance-department-edi>
- Testing for Release 3.1 began in April 2024 and must be completed by December 2, 2024.
  - This includes both FROI and SROI testing.
  - All Trading Partners (or their vendors) must complete and pass both FROI and SROI Testing in order to move to 3.1.
  - Failure to pass testing for 3.1 will result in your organization being unable to submit EDI to Virginia and therefore, being out of compliance with our requirements and subject to fines/penalties for any transaction that may become due and not filed within the required timeframe.
  - You can find the testing information on the EDI Quality Assurance Page of the Commission's website.
  - Exceptions: No testing is required for VWC Web Entry filers using Verisk wcPrism.
- The last day to submit transactions via EDI Release 3.0 is January 15, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.



## Report Cards

The last page of our Report Cards provide the requirements we use to pull the data for each quarterly Report Card. Using these requirements, each Trading Partner should be able to query their own system to pull the information necessary to see how we arrived at their scores and answer any questions related to the Report Cards.

The Commission's EDI Quality Assurance Department is unable to provide claim specific information related to your scores or provided updated/current score information outside of our quarterly issued Report Cards.

## EDI Reminders

- **Fax Number** - The EDI QA's new fax number, which should be used effective immediately, is **804-823-6956**. Please be sure to utilize only this fax number going forward as the old fax number will be disconnected/decommissioned soon.
- **Fine Increase** - Effective December 1, 2024, all EDI related fines will be increased from \$250 to \$500 per occurrence, as structured in Section 65.2-902, Code of Virginia.
